Seniors

Active play has been incredibly popular with our senior students, providing them with plenty of opportunities to engage in a wide range of exciting sports and games. Recipe of the Fortnight

This week at Foodie Friday we made Apple Ring Pastries! The children get to measure, mix, roll with all the different ingredients.

APPLE RING PASTRIES!

Ingredients:

1kg red apples1 packet of puff pastry1 packet of puff pastry (dairy free)

Instructions:

- 1. Peel and cut the apple in thick slices crosswise. I remove a sliver from the top and the bottom of the apple, then cut each into four slices.
- 2. Remove the core and make a hole in the middle. I used a round cookie cutter 1 inch in diameter. But you can cut with a knife.
- 3. Cut the puff pastry into strips. I use this roller, but you can cut with a simple knife. These strips don't need to be perfect so don't worry too much about straight lines.
- 4. I cut the pastry lengthwise into 1-inch strips, and then into shorter little strips about 2 inches long.
- 5. You are welcome to test it out before you cut all your strips. Each strip should go around the apple ring one time and can be stretched too.
