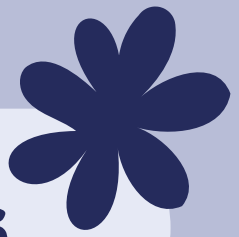

World Lizard Day!

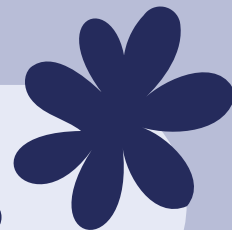

On Friday, 9 August, we had a blast in the kitchen for Foodie Friday! We tried our hand at making cinnamon rolls, and they turned out delicious.

We used simple ingredients:

- Puff pastry
- Brown sugar
- Butter; and
- Ground cinnamon

First, the children rolled out the puff pastry and brushed it with butter. Then, they sprinkled a generous amount of brown sugar and cinnamon, rolled it up, and cut it into perfect little spirals. We popped them in the oven, and the magic happened in just 15 minutes!

While the rolls baked, we whipped up a quick icing with powdered sugar and water. Once the cinnamon rolls cooled, we drizzled the icing on top, making them extra special.

The best part? The children couldn't get enough! They were so proud of their creations and even asked if we could make them again next week.

This activity wasn't just tasty; it was also a great way for the children to practice fine motor skills like brushing, rolling, and cutting. Plus, there's nothing like seeing their faces light up with joy and pride!
