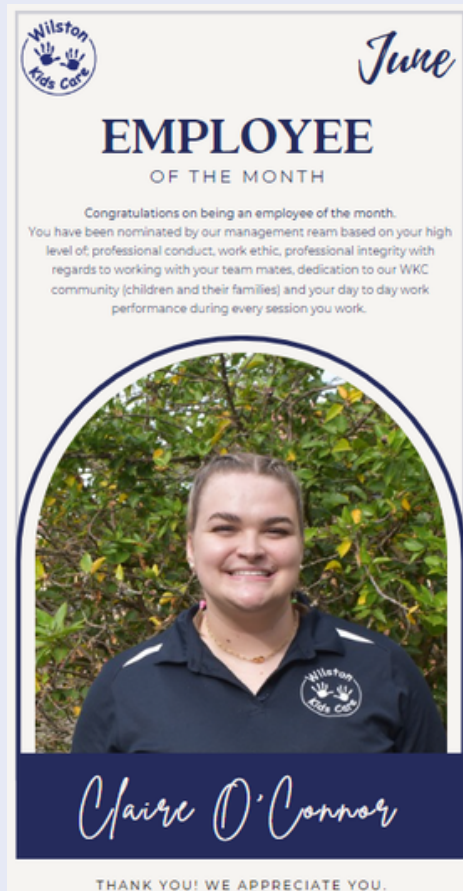


Employee Of the Month

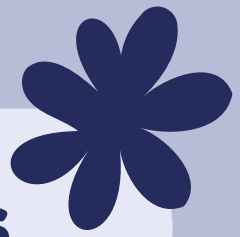

"Lifting us up when times are low and celebrating us in our highs, they are the teachers, the survivors, the ones that bring tenacity and strength and nurture us into good health and wellbeing". "They keep our bellies full and our culture strong, sharing stories as we draw strength from their knowledge and experience". "We always listen to our Elders, but most of all respect and cherish what they pass down! Our Elders hold a prominent place in our community and family". "These polos aren't just fabric. They reflect a community's history, identity, and values. When people wear significant pieces like these, they often feel a deep sense of emotional and cultural connection, and we can gain a better understanding of the diversity and richness of human culture". "These Polos provide opportunities to spark educational conversation and pay respect to our First Nations People past, present and emerging".

National OSHC Educators' Day

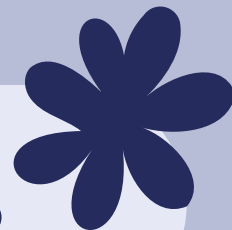
Celebrating Our Exceptional WKC Team on National OSHC Educators' Day
